Candidates without terminal degrees will hold the rank of Instructor, Non-Tenure Track. Applications for a visiting position will also be considered.

RESPONSIBILITIES: The candidate is expected to excel in areas of teaching, research, and service related to the launch of Otterbein's BS in Business Analytics. Research responsibilities include publishing in peer-reviewed journals and presenting at peer-reviewed conferences in areas related to analytics. Faculty members must be able to teach evening and weekend classes, as well as daytime classes. Faculty members are expected to be involved in professional and community activities for the purposes of scholarship, self-development and service.
